- **Minutes from Last Meeting:** Motion made to accept; Members voted; Passed
- **Treasurer's Report:** Read; Motion made to accept; Voted; Passed
- Trail 999 clearing has started. Contact Arnie to get information on helping. Still need help to clear trails. Need help monitoring use of Sweeco operations.
- Emails from Dan: If you are not getting information from Dan about club events, contact him through the Back Country ATV/UTV webpage at BackCountry.org.
- Sportsman's Expo schedules were handed out. Work date is May 15th to 17th. Free tickets have not been given. Only a few may be given for workers. Tickets cost \$7. If you are able, please volunteer to pay for your ticket this year.
- Fun Run permit agreement from the Forest Service has been signed by Wid. Fun Run is June 20th. It will be on the 614 trail south of highway 41 at the 4th of July pass. Parking, start of Fun Run, and free BBQ will be located on the north side. Game prices will be posted. Raffle tickets will be available for purchase. Members are asked to donate food for BBQ and raffle items. Need help with stations, preparing food, selling tickets, and clean up. The event will be advertised to the public.
- Club has been asked to help pay for the pumping of the outhouse at the Warming Hut. Motion was made to pay \$100 to help pay for the pumping of the outhouse; second made; members voted; motion was passed to pay \$100 for the pumping of the outhouse at the Warming Hut.
- Juff Burns from Search and Rescue shared that he is called 3-4 times a week for emergency rescues. There are more and more people on the trails. He suggested that all members take radios or SPOT Messengers with them in case of an emergency. You can get the SPOT Messengers at sports shops. There is an annual service fee.
- Trail Rides: contact Dan if you want to lead a ride. May 2 is first ride scheduled. Rides list has been posted on the club webpage.
- Legislature: Chuck shared that bill HS129 has passed. The club was in support of this bill. He shared information about several other bills and asked members to contact him if they want more info.
- Drawings: 50% Marc Quinn won \$60; 25% Jeri Siel would have won \$233.25 if he had been present.
- Meeting adjourned at 7:20 pm; Next meeting May 19, 6:30 pm, at JB's in CDA.
