**EDITORIAL**

The following information was taken from the latest ARRA News letter, of which I hope by now you are all subscribing to on your computer...it's free! Anyway, here is the latest on the Forest Service Planning Rule Process.

The Forest Service is well on its way to developing a new planning rule to govern the management of our national Forests and Grasslands. On July 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>, we attended the 4<sup>th</sup> National Roundtable the Forest Service held on the Planning Rule. As we reported in an earlier newsletter, the Forest Service now understands that "recreation" should be a key topic in any planning rule. This recognition on its part is the result of thousands of communications by ARRA members and other recreation enthusiasts stating that recreating at our National Forests is a priority on the part of the American people and therefore should be priority by the agency responsible for managing those public lands.

In terms of the timetable going forward, the Forest Service expects to release a proposed rule by December of this year. Once the proposed rule is published in

the Federal Register, we will have 60 days to submit our comments. ARRA will notify you once the proposed rule is released and the comment period begins.

The Forest Service expects to have the Final Rule in force by November, 2011, assuming, of course, litigation doesn't interfere with that timetable.

### **BIG BROTHER IS WATCHING YOU (or will be)**

As we all know, or should know by now, the "Big Brothers" are going to close up our trails again this coming Labor Day. Remember, they are only open for us to ride on from Memorial Day to Labor Day, isn't that wonderful? The best time to ride, and here we sit again on our machines, on the roads with lots of traffic, while the elk walk on our trails. That is before we scare them all away with our machines, according to IDF&G. I bet that you guys down south wish that you had a riding season like we do up here. I understand that yours is longer than ours is. I wonder what IDF&G governs your areas. Surely could not be the same one that puts a stop to our riding. Sure does make you wonder how things are run in different areas doesn't it. Well, anyway, folks, be sure to watch for those yellow signs designating "seasonally closed", you can rest assured that the law enforcement folks will be watching for you.

### **TRAILS (whats left of them)**

For those of you that were not on the night ride last night, here is a bit of information that maybe you didn't know. If you have ever driven on the 278 road over to the Happy Hermit, and went by the overlook of the lake, you had noticed that the road getting there was really bad in some spots, with rocks and ruts in most of it. Well, it seems that they have taken a road grader and smoothed the whole road out and made it wider in spots. So the trip to the Hermit is like a Sunday drive now. In addition to that, if you know the 2707a trail, which comes off of the 278, there was a gate there that you had to go around. Well, do I have to tell you who did this? There was a full size road grader sitting right in the middle of the trail, making it impassable. The rest of it looked like a two lane road. That was one of the best ATV trails in the woods, and now it's gone. So I guess you should be careful of full sized cars on that too.

### **RATHDRUM MOUNTAIN ADVENTURE RACE**

Adventure race on Rathdrum Mountain this coming September 11<sup>th</sup>. They are looking for folks to volunteer to be on the road portion for the bicycles to guide them along the route, so they don't take any turnoffs and get lost. *INTERMEDIATE* – Experienced riding skills **RECOMMENDED:** roads/trails, possibly some steep slopes, side hills, or loose rocks  
*COMBINATION* – Combination of difficulties, various terrain i.e. Intermediate to Difficult abilities  
*DIFFICULT* – Experienced riding skills **REQUIRED:** trails requiring 4WD, obstacle navigation, rocky, side hills, and slower travel

**SILVER DOLLAR BAR RIDE, SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 11TH – (EASY)**

Leave from the Wallace parking lot at 8:00am. Exit at 61 go to the stop sign at bottom of off ramp. Turn right, and then cross the street into the big dirt parking lot on your left. UTV friendly.
