- Arnie passed a survey questioner around to attending members. He was asking for our opinion on widening the trails to 60" or keeping the trails "as is". He wanted this information to present to the ISATV meeting this week. The general consensus was to keep the trails "as is", and work on a solution for bigger units. Arnie stated that Utah uses the term "low pressure tires" in their regulations. This would keep larger vehicles off of the trails without determining width.
- Nancy reported we are still looking for entries for the "Logo contest". The winning entry will receive a \$100 prize. Logo entries need to be submitted by Sept 19 and will be voted on at the October meeting.
